Applicants may also be anyone who is obtaining an Associate or Bachelor Degree. You yourself must be a primary member of Sharefax Credit Union to be eligible.

- 3. In addition to scholarships, how do you plan to finance the rest of your education? How can a credit union help you?
- 4. What has been your most rewarding community involvement experience and why?

Please answer the following question by attaching your typed, double-spaced response. (<u>Entries should be no longer</u> than four pages, and we strongly encourage creativity.)

5. Credit unions often play a vital role in promoting financial well-being within communities. Describe your understanding of financial well-being and the unique benefits that credit unions offer compared to traditional banks. How has your experience with or knowledge of credit unions shaped your perspective on financial health? Discuss how you plan to leverage this understanding to enhance your own financial future and contribute to the financial wellness of others in your community.
